North Nibley Garden of Remembrance – Regulations

The North Nibley Cemetery Regulations also apply to the Garden of Remembrance.

These regulations apply to the **original** (eastern) part of the Garden of Remembrance.

- 1. All memorial designs must be submitted to a monthly North Nibley Parish Council meeting for Burial Authority approval before the memorial is commissioned.
- 2. Each plot in the Garden of Remembrance is 18 inches by 18 inches (457mm by 457mm). Each memorial to be of maximum dimensions 12 inches by 8 inches (300mm by 200mm). Plots will be allocated by the Burial Clerk.
- 3. A flat slab of maximum dimensions 9 inches by inches (228mm by 228mm) and an inscribed vase placed on it may be substituted for a memorial.
- 4. Wall plaques must be 6 inches by 4 inches (150mm by 100mm). Plaques on memorials should be 6 inches by 4 inches for single individuals and 6 inches by 8 inches for doubles (alternatively 9 inches by 6 inches for double plots).
- 5. Memorial to be fitted by BRAMM or equivalent body approved stonemason.
- 6. One flower receptacle allowed per memorial and this should be placed on top (maximum height & width 160mm). No other ornamentation permitted on top of the memorial or surrounding it.
- 7. Dead or unsightly flowers/displays will be removed when necessary. Plastic flowers will be removed after 12 weeks.
- 8. No plants, shrubs or bulbs permitted amongst or around the memorials.

Any object in the Garden of Remembrance which contravenes the above regulations will be moved to the corner of the Cemetery to be collected by the owner within 12 weeks, or disposed of thereafter.
