

# North Nibley Garden of Remembrance – Regulations

*The North Nibley Cemetery Regulations also apply to the Garden of Remembrance.*

These regulations apply to the new (western) part of the Garden of Remembrance.

1. All memorials must receive North Nibley Parish Council Burial Authority's approval before installation.
2. Each plot in the Garden of Remembrance is 18inches by 18inches (457mm by 457mm). Each memorial to be of maximum dimensions 12inches by 8 inches (300mm by 200mm). The maximum height of a memorial to be 4 inches (100mm). Plots will be allocated by the Burial Clerk.
3. A monochrome photographic image of the deceased may be laser etched onto the memorial. However the layout and a copy of the image must be approved by North Nibley Parish Council as the Burial Authority.
4. A flat slab of dimensions 12 inches by 12 inches (300mm by 300mm) and an inscribed vase placed on it may be substituted for a memorial.
5. Memorial to be fitted by BRAMM or equivalent body approved stonemason.
6. One flower receptacle allowed per memorial and this may be either built into the memorial itself or placed on top (maximum height & width 160mm). No other ornamentation permitted on top of the memorial or surrounding it.
7. Dead or unsightly flowers/displays will be removed when necessary. Plastic flowers will be removed after 12 weeks.
8. No plants, shrubs or bulbs permitted amongst or around the memorials.
9. No spiked flower holders are allowed in this area as there is a protective membrane under the surface.

Placement of any object in the Garden of Remembrance which contravenes the above regulations will be moved to the corner of the Cemetery to be collected by the owner within 12 weeks, or disposed of thereafter.
